PROJECT PROCESS SO FAR

Recommendations to address the split incentive issue

SmartSPIN has established a **set of guidelines and recommendations** to optimise the approach around the **split incentive and smart energy services for the commercial rented sector**. To do it, <u>Lawler Sustainability</u> has carried out a study of the recommendations to address the split incentive issue, green leasing, on-bill financing, energy performance contracting and other related schemes such as metered energy efficiency transaction structure.





What are the Smart Energy Services Markets in the current commercial rented sector?

During the first year, the <u>International Energy Research Centre (IERC)</u> has led and conducted the **review of the smart energy services markets for commercial rented sector**. This evaluation was performed in countries represented by the <u>SmartSPIN consortium</u> - Greece, Ireland, The Netherlands, and Spain - as well as countries with matured ESCOs market.
